*Strategic intercession for abused Children*

Then, I heard the voice of the Lord say to me, "Now, go to the gate and command the release of these innocent ones!"

At the click of a mouse, anyone can pull up statistics of abused, enslaved, and neglected children. Yet, calling down judgment on the transgressors is not enough. According to Isaiah 53:12b, we need to intercede for the salvation of this perverted generation. Stand with us to sabotage the enemy's plans of destruction of our young ones.
